**Pray** for those sick or in need; Amy Vink, Helen Clapham, Judy Demeral, Joy Wilkinson, Helen & Vic Harper.

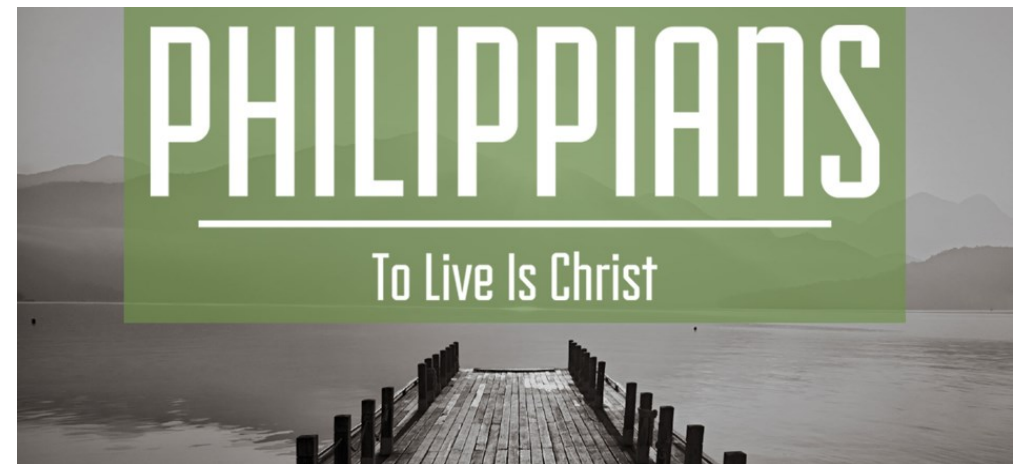

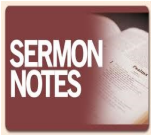
